



OPERATION CEASEFIRE

OPERATION CEASEFIRE is a Beaumont Police Department (BPD) initiative aimed at **interdicting, reducing and disrupting Shots Fired and Deadly Conduct incidents** including an increased number of Drive-By Shooting events.

Elements of BPD's Special Assignment Unit (SAU), Special Services Detail (SSD), Criminal Investigation Division (CID), Patrol Division, The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office (JCSO) worked together in a focused effort to recover firearms during this operation **in order to effect a reduction in firearms-related incidents** within the City of Beaumont.

891 Traffic Stops conducted during **OPERATION CEASEFIRE**

resulted in:

268 Arrests

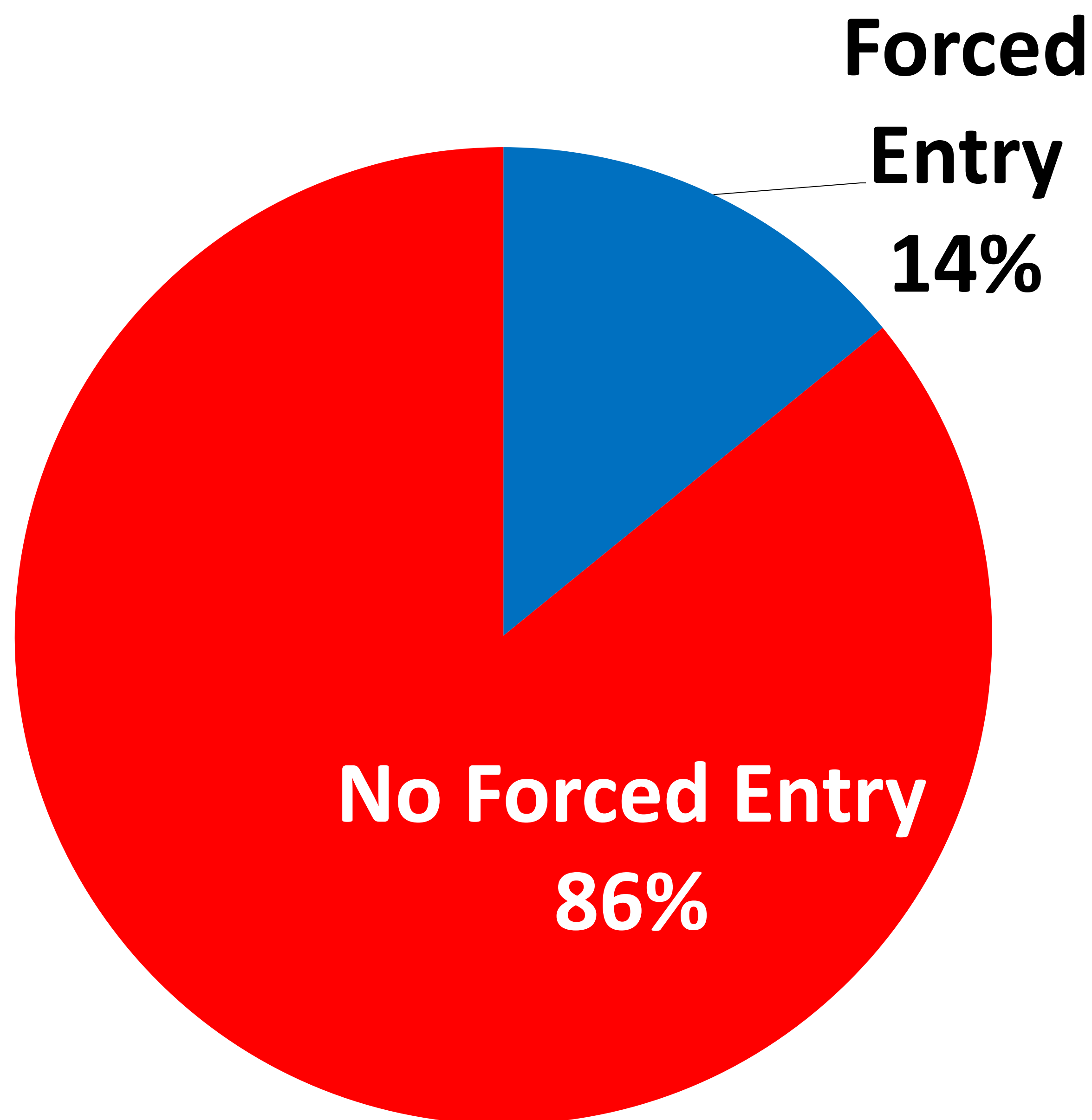
80 Firearms Recovered

Shots Fired Calls for Service have remained at lower volumes consistently for the last six weeks.

99 Firearms have been stolen from vehicles in Beaumont this year to date.

86% of firearms stolen from vehicles in 2023 were stolen from unsecured vehicles.
