Chief Tim Ocnaschek discussed some highlights from 2024. This included the noticeable violent crime reduction from 2023 and 100% clearing of all homicides. The budget was discussed: additional positions for RTCC and combining two part times into a full time position, new vehicles, funding received for Lexipol. RTCC had its grand opening and already there are 2700 registered and 1300 integrated cameras. The 1999 cold case on Kim Langwell was cleared and received national recognition.

They also discussed some early 2025 details/goals. CPA was beginning that night for any Advisory Committee member who had yet to participate. They also discussed RTCC recent successes, their new staffing, and connectivity of cameras.
