New committee member, Alexia Morgan introduced herself. Chief spoke on the city bond meetings. An update was given on the Real Time Crime Center including discussions about: the accomplishment of 3600 cameras, four new positions budgeted for, the PSN grant, FBI violent crime task force, SEMG warrants, and grants for technology recruitment and retention of officers were discussed as well as a staffing update given – 13 openings as of that day. Violent crime being down was discussed as well as a joint initiative with the FBI. The success of National Night Out and its good community response were spoken about.

A question was asked about how the police are connecting with children and providing resources. The Mayor responded that not all problems are for police to fix and how he appreciated both our police department and the active participation of the police community advisory committee. Mr. Sam spoke about having patrol visible throughout neighborhoods. Potential camera/fusus service funding was discussed as well as Mr. Javed mentioning liaisons having discussions with hot spot areas.
